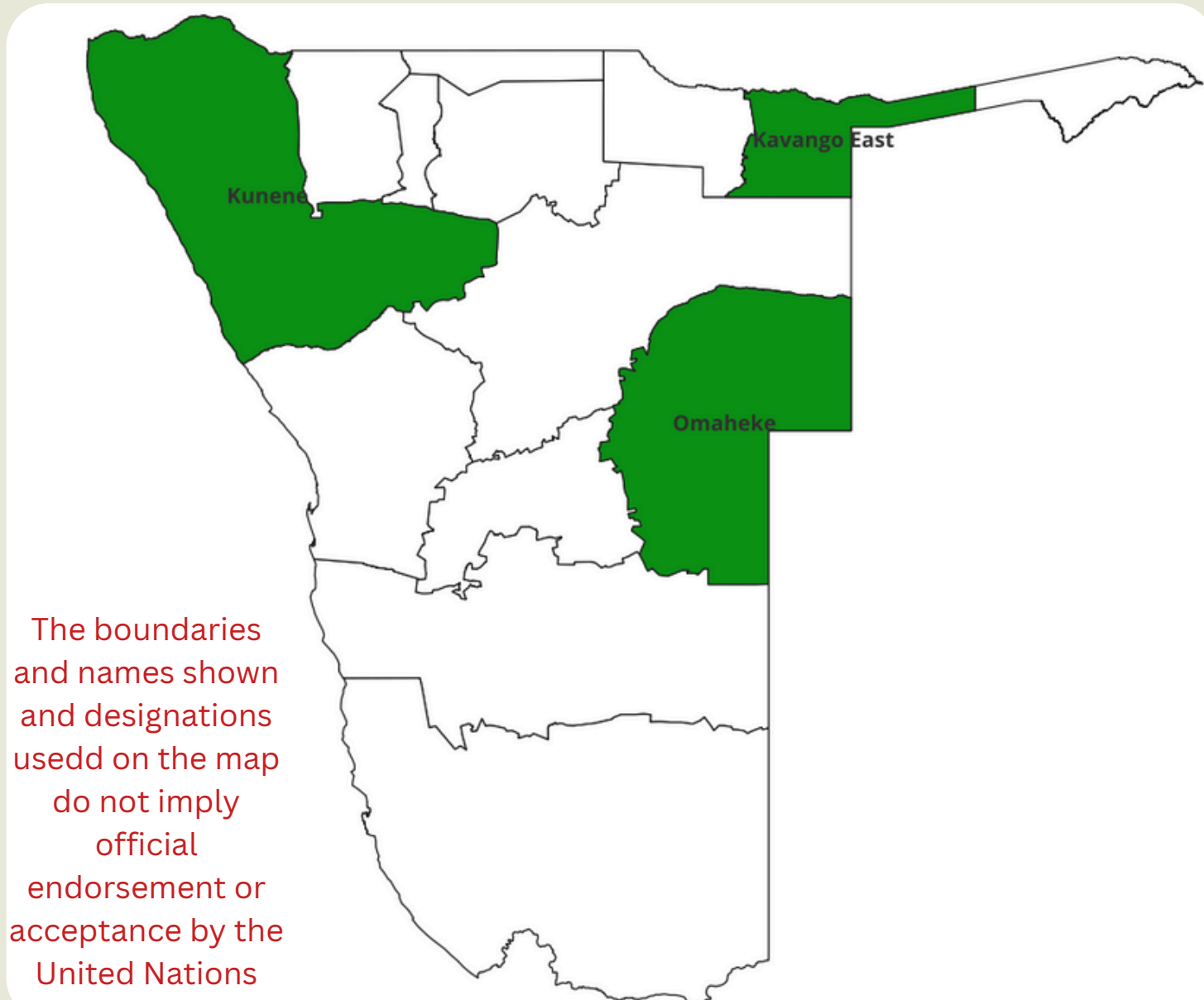

To build the capacity of the marginalised community, empower and promote marginalised youth engagements in climate change discussions.

Project Inception Assessments, Climate Change Capacity Building workshops and implementation of youth-led climate action projects, respond to the needs of marginalized youth community and establish climate smart school clubs.
